- The NASCLA-Accredited Examination Program was designed to assist contractors who work in multiple states.
- NASCLA stands for the National Association of State Contractors Licensing Agencies.
- This association is composed of 15 state agencies that have worked together to enact laws to regulate the business of contractors.

How does becoming NASCLA-accredited benefit you?

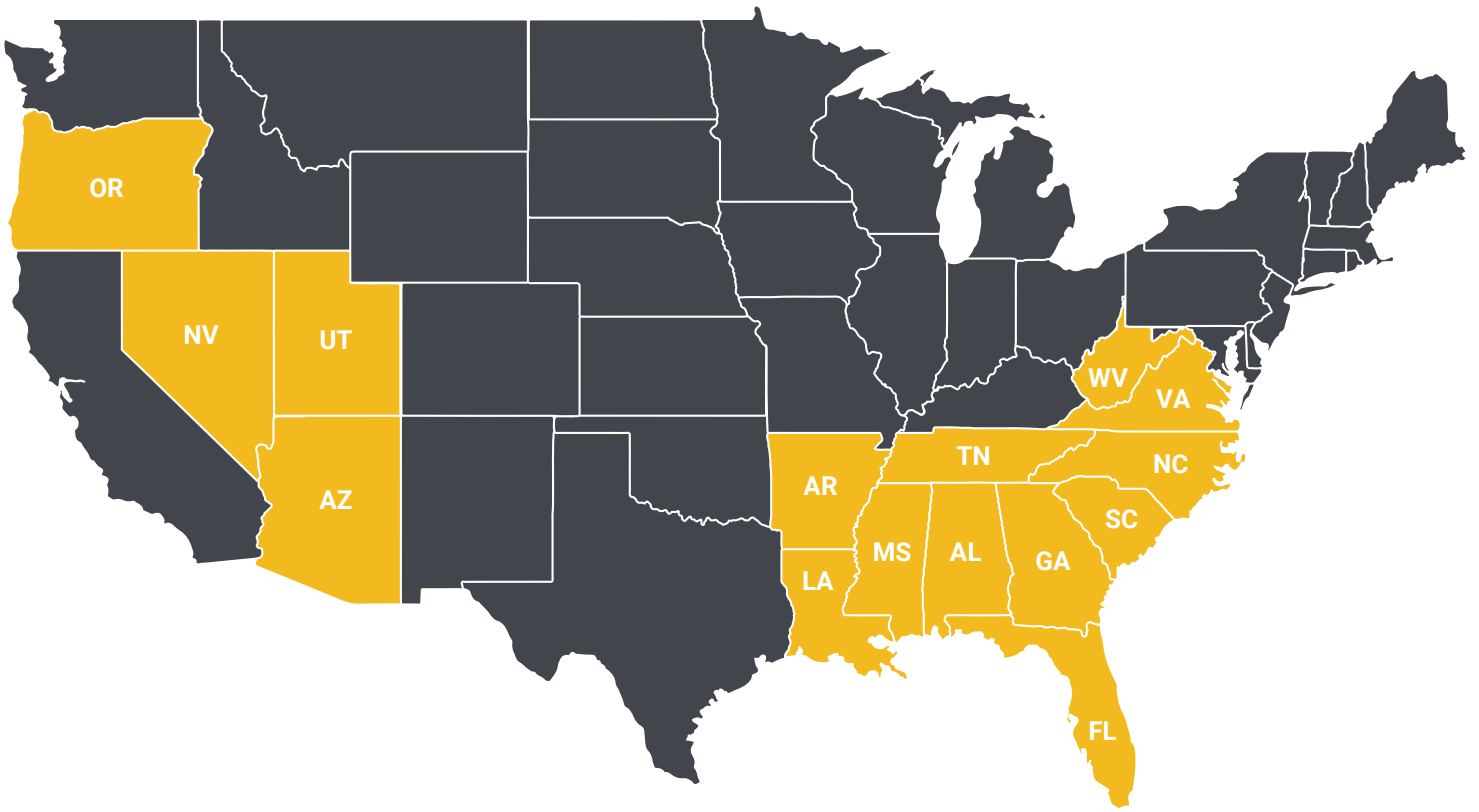
Becoming a NASCLA accredited contractor means you can take one trades exam to work in AL, AR, AZ, FL, GA, LA, MS, NV, NC, OR, SC, TN, UT, US Virgin Islands, VA, and WV.

You will save time and money by passing the NASCLA-Accredited exam, rather than passing a Commercial Trades exam in 15 States & the Virgin Islands.

You will have to complete the Business Law Exam for every state you wish to work in except Arkansas. Arkansas accepts the NASCLA exam as both trades and business/law.

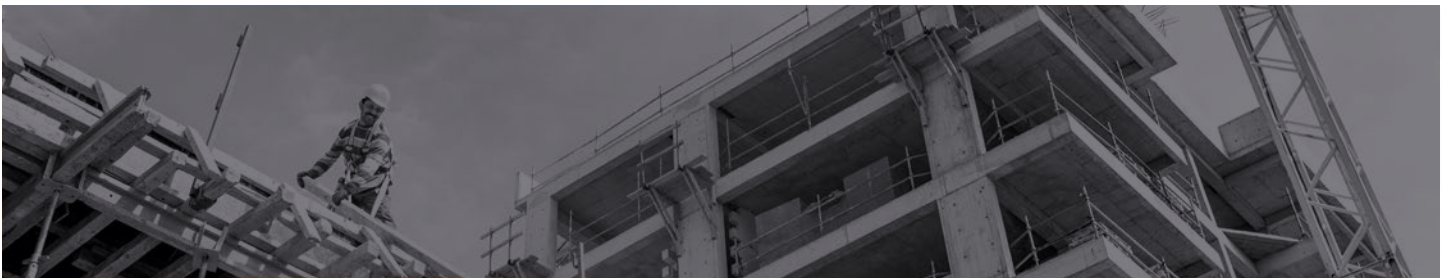
How Do I Become A NASCLA Contractor?

- Submit the application and \$25 fee at: ned.nascla.org
 - Submit the Examination Security Video agreement at the bottom of [this page](#).
 - Acquire the [21 books](#) necessary to complete the exam from a reputable source.**
 - Complete an [exam prep program](#) that prepares you for using the reference books.**
 - You have up to 1 year from your approval date to sit for the exam with a maximum of 3 attempts to pass. – study for the exam with [online HD video prep!](#)
 - Once you pass the test, your electronic transcript will automatically be uploaded to the National Examination Database (ned.nascla.org) within 48 hours. You can then create an account to submit your pass score to the state you are applying to be licensed in. You will receive a physical copy of your pass score at PSI's testing facility immediately after the exam.

Chapter 3

What's On The NASCLA Exam?



There are 115 questions and you must get 81 answers correct. You will have 330 minutes to complete the exam.

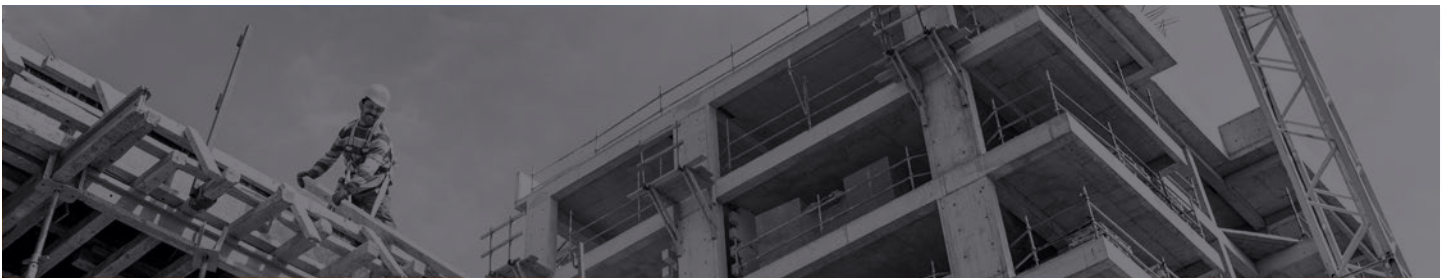
The NASCLA exam is designed to test your ability to find information in the 21 NASCLA books.

How Do I Prepare For The NASCLA Exam?

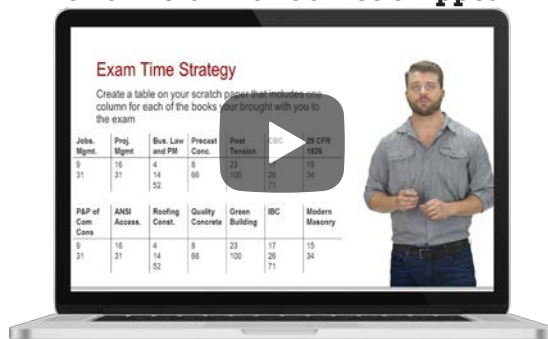
